The management team and staff are dedicated, hard-working and always give of their best to ensure Northwood School remains formidable and the "School of Choice".

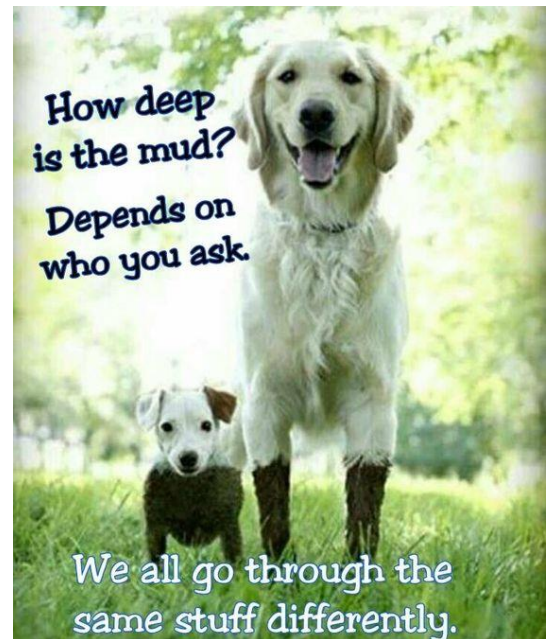
Thank you to the School Governing Body and parents who give of their time and expertise to make Northwood the best it can be.

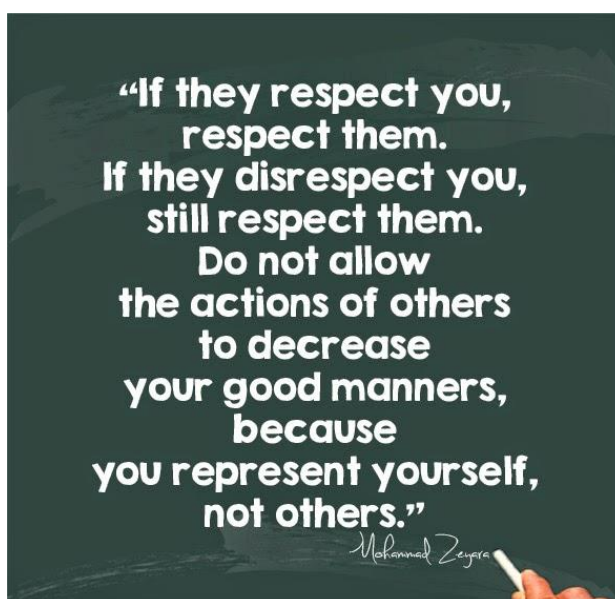
