Learner Support and extension programs

Please be aware that there will be significant adjustments to our learner support program going forward into term three.

A special learner support centre is being developed during the holiday with the specific aim of supporting our grade 8 and 9 boys who need academic reinforcement.

The centre will have designated staff assigned to it, who will through the grade tutors, subject teachers and GET – academic head, ensure that boys assigned to this centre have the resources and support they need to improve in the specific areas in which they require help. The centre will also be equipped with computers and education software where boys will be able to follow reading programmes, language programmes and mathematical reinforcement.

Parents will receive notification from the centre manager that their son is required to attend and their attendance will be compulsory. Parents will then receive a weekly report on the activities completed by their son as well as the progress made.

The centre will also allow boys, who would like to extend themselves, to access past exam papers, worksheets and additional textbooks. All the grade 12 papers from the last 5 years, both department and IEB, will be made available for or boys to download. They would also, of course, be welcome to use the various software programmes which cover a wide variety of subjects.

Mrs Morton's homework centre will continue to operate on the upper campus, where the mentors and peer tutors will still be available for support. The two centres will liaise with each other to ensure our efforts are properly aligned.

We are extremely excited about this program and ask that you provide us with your full support in this regard.

Infrastructure upgrades

During the course of the holiday work on upgrading our ablution facilities and the two science blocks leading onto the matric quad will be finalised. These improvements will certainly improve, not only our general ablution facility, but also add significant value to the teaching and learning environment.

A special thank you to Mr Beukes and his team for the effort that is going into these projects.
